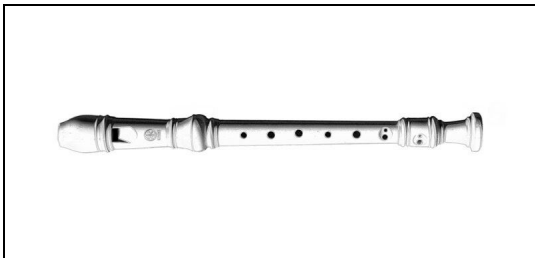
FUNd Run 2020 - Final Days to Participate!



Your registration fees and donations **directly support D112 students in need** with essential items such as school supplies, books, and music instrument rentals. These funds will be needed this year more than ever!

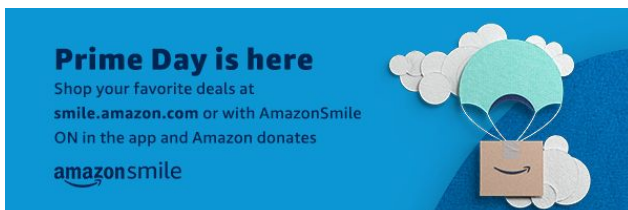
