STUDENT CONSENT - COVID19 SALIVA SCREENING - If you are interested in saliva testing, and did not have a chance to sign up, please fill out the attached consent form. Consent must be submitted by Wednesday at 4:00 pm to be included in the following week's testing. You only need to consent once and your child will automatically receive a testing kit the following week and every week after. You do not need to sign consent weekly. **Consent is due by Wednesday, March 3rd at 4:00 pm to be included in testing the week of March 8th.** There is no cost to any family for any testing, this is part of the District 112 COVID-19 emergency funding.
