District 112 Updates - PCR Testing

North Shore School District **highly encourages** all families to opt into this opportunity **as the goal is to further reduce, prevent the spread and increase school community safety.**

PCR testing will REPLACE the weekly saliva screening.

Testing is voluntary and will require consent to participate. If a child were to test positive, the District will consult with the Lake County Health Department and refer to the [IDPH Interim Exclusion Guidance](#).

If you wish to have your child(ren) participate in the COVID-19 screening, a consent form will need to be completed for **each child**. The consent will remain open for the remainder of the school year and must be completed by Sunday to participate in the following week.
